



ACCOUNT FOR DUE DILIGENCE ON FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS AND DECENT WORKING CONDITIONS

THIS ACCOUNT IS SIGNED BY THE BOARD OF ONESUBSEA PROCESSING AS. IT ALSO COVERS RELEVANT SUBSIDIARIES WITHIN THE COMPANY GROUP

OneSubsea Processing AS ("OSSP") with subsidiaries is incorporated under the laws of Norway. OSSP is owned by Schlumberger Norge AS (70%), Aker Solutions Holding AS (20%) and Subsea 7 Holding UK Ltd (10%). OSSP is an integral part of the OneSubsea joint venture established in 2023 and the parent company of other OneSubsea entities in Norway.

OSSP is headquartered in Norway and has been operating in Norway since 1983. OSSP's subsidiaries are located in Norway and incorporated under Norwegian law.

The company's operations are split between office-based operations, manufacturing, construction, commissioning activities and service operations offshore. OSSP has offices, laboratories, manufacturing facilities and workshops in Bergen, Lysaker, Gjøvik, Moss, Ågotnes, Tranby, Haugesund and Horsøy. Some of our technical experts work at our customers' facilities onshore and offshore to offer support and closely follow up throughout project execution—from early works such as modelling and analysis through planning to execution.

Following review of the SLB Modern Slavery Report [Modern Slavery Report 2024](#), the Board of OSSP has adopted this report as its account for due diligence on fundamental human rights and decent working conditions pursuant to the Norwegian Transparency Act Section 5, albeit with the following Norway specific additions relevant to the local Human Rights Due Diligence program:

In 2024, OSSP reviewed and updated its human rights impact assessment. Based on the results, to date, no actual adverse impacts were identified, nor any significant risks of adverse impacts through our due diligence. In 2025, OSSP will continue its internal awareness efforts about human rights and decent working conditions, as well as working with its suppliers through a risk-based pre-qualification process and audits to ensure that its suppliers understand the obligation to have adequate routines in place to reduce risks for negative impacts on people.

Following this, the Board of OneSubsea Processing AS unanimously decided to approve this statement for publication and instructed the company to ensure that it is published no later than June 30th, 2025.
